**APPLICATION PROCEDURE**

1. Complete the admission process for entry into Carl Albert State College.
2. Complete the *Application for Admission* to the Associate of Applied Science in Nursing Program. Application packets are available from the Division of Health Sciences. All documentation specified in the application packet must be turned in with the application by the February 1<sup>st</sup> deadline. A student who has been dismissed by the faculty from any of the CASC Health Science programs is not eligible for admission to the nursing program.
3. Provide the Department of Nursing Education an official copy of your high school transcript and official transcripts of all colleges attended (including CASC).
4. Provide the Department of Nursing Education a copy of your ACT scores (and Accuplacer Reading score if required it is for reading level verification).
5. The application process must be completed by February 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. It is the applicant's responsibility to provide all required forms and information by the February 1<sup>st</sup> deadline.

Upon admission into the nursing program, the applicant will be required to complete a departmental Health Survey form, Criminal Background Check, Urine Drug Screen.
